POST-SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS

E N V I R O N M E N T

Erythema (redness) are likely to occur in the 1 to 3 days following service; this may persist in some individuals. Mild to moderate edema (swelling) and mild to moderate warming sensation may also occur in the 1 to 3 days following service. Hot water and steam should be avoided when showering for 48 hours. Sun exposure should be avoided for 4 to 6 weeks following treatment to decrease the chance of spotty pigmentation. Apply sun block SPF 30+ UVA and UVB throughout the treatment period, and regular daily use moving forward. Sunscreen with titanium oxide, zinc oxide provides broader protection. Avoid swimming entirely for 7 days.

B E H A V I O R S

Cleansing: A topical ointment is applied before leaving the office; do not rinse until instructed by your provider. Use the at-home care package provided to you for 3 to 4 days following service. Treatment may result in crusting, and flaking. These areas should flake on their own in 2 to 7 days. Failure to adhere may result in hyperpigmentation.

Product Use: Use of make-up is permitted after 24 hours post-service; however, do not apply makeup to area(s) experiencing oozing or warmth. Your provider will advise when your regular skincare regimen can resume. Suspend shaving the treatment area(s) for 5 days post-service, and suspend waxing for 3 weeks post-service.

Observation: Treatment will results in brown spots/sun damage darkening, crusting, and flaking. These areas should flake on their own in 7 to 10 days on the face, and up to 4 to 6 weeks on areas of the body. Failure to adhere may result in hyperpigmentation.
